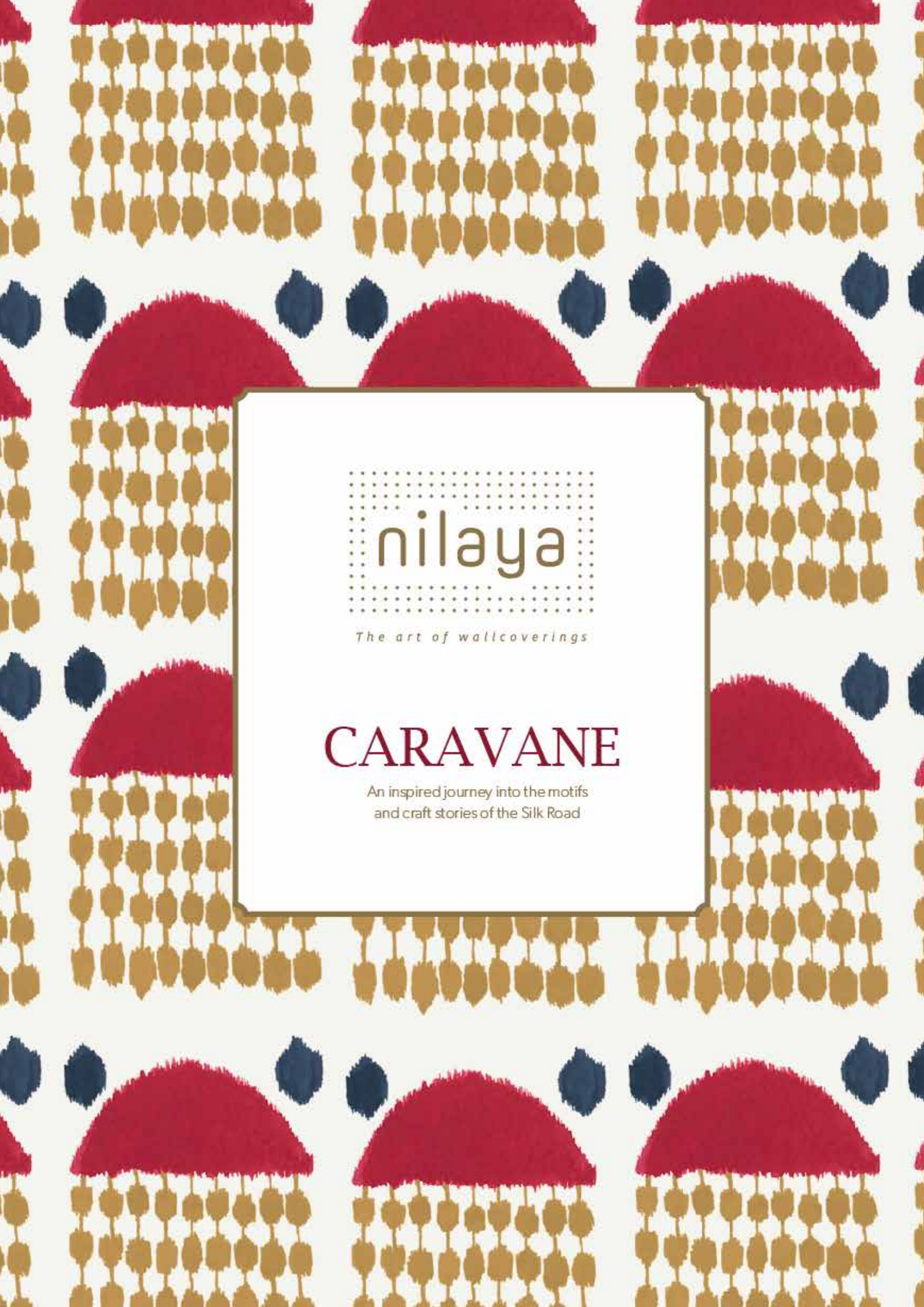

A bespoke series of wallcoverings created by Pavitra Rajaram for Nilaya, Caravane celebrates the trade of cultures, ideas and design stories that occurred along the historic Silk Road. A centuries-old arterial network that connected civilizations, this route ensured a cultural osmosis through craft, motifs, colors and ideas. The flowing silks from Istanbul and Persian brocades to the block prints from the Indian subcontinent and the lush botanical prints from China found their way into the finest homes across the world.

The collection explores these diverse traditions, motifs and patterns that spread throughout the world, and breathes fresh life into antique crafts. These wallcoverings are more than bespoke decor for contemporary homes; they highlight a luminous legacy and celebrate an ancient inheritance.
